

For Stevens, Ferry, Pend Oreille, & Lincoln counties

With the federal government shut down, SNAP benefits will end November 1. Rural Resources is compiling a list of food resources for people in Stevens, Ferry, Pend Oreille, and Lincoln counties who may need additional food support. Any person or organization is welcome to use and share this document.

This document is a collective community effort and will continue to be regularly updated. We also have a Food Drive guide that we're updating daily.

Things to know

- You will be able to use your existing balance on your SNAP card after November 1, but funds will not be added to it.
- The WIC Nutrition Program will continue providing food benefits through mid-late November.
- All school districts in Stevens, Ferry, Pend Oreille, and Lincoln counties offer two free meals (breakfast & lunch) each day to all students – no application needed. See full list of participating schools here.
