

Grammar Practice - Conditionals

Second Conditional: Refers to an imaginary situation in the present or future.

- If + past, would + present.

Third Conditional: Refers to an imaginary situation in the past.

- If + had + past participle, would + have + past participle.

Mixed Conditional: Refers to an imaginary situation and its probable effect on the present or vice versa.
