

Hello!

Thank you so much for expressing interest about participating in the 2024 Mahomet-Seymour Homecoming Parade. This year the parade will begin at **5:30 pm on Wednesday, September 18**. The parade will leave from the high school parking lot, exiting out State Street. We will have specific “areas” as to where your float/truck/car needs to be, as opposed to a certain location for each individual vehicle. The locations are named A-E and are illustrated on the provided map of the high school parking lot. The sections are as follows:

Section A: police, fire dept., grand marshals, American Legion, marching band, etc.

Section B: high school class floats

Section C: convertibles/Jeeps/trucks for homecoming court members

Section D: teams / clubs

Section E: businesses/community entries

You will need to be there, or have your **driver** be there, between 4:00-4:45 pm on Wednesday. The specific order of vehicles in section D and section E does not make a difference. If you want to be with other similar entries, you should coordinate to arrive at the same time (perhaps meet on a side street and enter the high school parking lot together). If you are in section B or section C, please enter the parking lot through the back entrance by the football field off of Crowley. If you are in section A, D, or E, please be sure to enter through the main entrance on the south side of the parking lot (off of State Street). Due to the congested nature of the parking lot, we need you to move all the way forward in your line-up location. If you have any questions, look for a Parade Committee member wearing a safety vest, and he/she can help you find where you need to go.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The high school parking lot is the staging area for parade vehicles only. There will be very limited parking available for participants riding floats. If possible, please park at MSJH, Lincoln Trail, or somewhere nearby and walk to the high school to find your parade entry. Also, please do not arrive before 4pm.

Remember, this year’s theme is Vive Paris! Please decorate your entry according to the theme, in Bulldog Orange and Blue, or both!
