4	GSR	Randy T	<p>GSR attended the monthly District 24 GSR meeting on Wednesday 5/14.</p> <p>Matthew, our delegate from California Northern Interior Area of Alcoholics Anonymous 07 (CNIA 07) to which District 24 belongs, attended the 2025 General Service Conference (GSC) in New York, 4/27-5/3. Our District Committee Member (DCM), Ada R., shared that Matthew is scheduling sessions for each district in Area 07 to review his report from the GSC. Any member of AA may attend those sessions. He has not yet set a date for District 24 yet, but it will likely be sometime in July or August.</p> <p>North Hall will be holding our annual Group Inventory on Saturday, June 28, from 10:00am - 1:00pm in person at the hall. The output of the inventory helps the Steering Committee to plan our efforts for the coming year. This will be a facilitated session with flip charts around the hall. Participants will have the opportunity to capture their ideas on sticky notes in a breakout session, after which we will discuss the input. GSR will provide some light snacks. Please bring your own beverages.</p> <p>Participants who are unable to attend in person may join via the Group Conscience Zoom link. However, online participants will likely not have the same experience as those who attend in person. I would like to ask for volunteers to assist with the web cam, to monitor the Zoom participants for their input, and to be a microphone runner so that online participants can hear what is being discussed in the hall.</p> <p>The standard topics from “The A.A. Group” pamphlet for an annual inventory are as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. What is the basic purpose of our group?</li> <li>2. What more can our group do to carry the message?</li> <li>3. Is our group attracting alcoholics from different backgrounds? Are we seeing a good cross section of our community, including those with accessibility issues?</li> <li>4. Do new members stick with us, or does the turnover seem excessive? If so, why? What can we as a group do to retain members?</li> <li>5. Do we emphasize the importance of sponsorship? How effectively? How can we do it better?</li> <li>6. Are we careful to preserve the anonymity of our group members and other A.A.s outside the meeting rooms? Do we also leave what they share at meetings behind?</li> </ol>

As a result, it is very unlikely the landlord would do any work on the AC.</p> <p>The SC discussed that the amount of hot water available at the kitchen sink is limited, indicating an issue with the water heater. Given that we have been struggling to consistently meet our bills, it is recommended by the SC that we do nothing about the water heater, and if hot water is needed then it is available from the coffee maker in a pinch.</p> <p>The SC discussed the Outreach Committee and what its status is. Stacey to follow up with Rose on the status and on coordination with the proposed (now withdrawn) Pride Day event at the hall.</p>
