### Wiley Vineyard

2017 Pinot Noir from the famed Wiley Vineyard in the Deep End of Anderson Valley, California. Floral characters and aromas of dark fruit, combined with hints of sage, pennyroyal, and cinnamon. Warm pre-harvest period yielded a more robust yet still delicate wine with ever evolving aromatics. Begin drinking this wine in 2020 or cellar for 5+ years. Small hand-made production with 600 bottles produced.

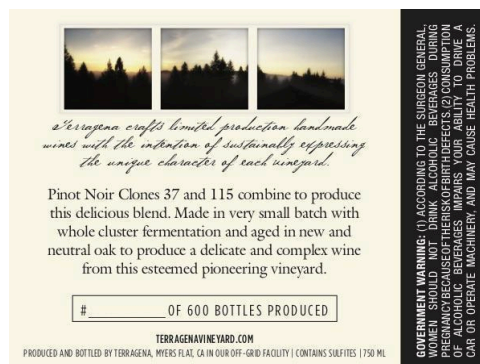
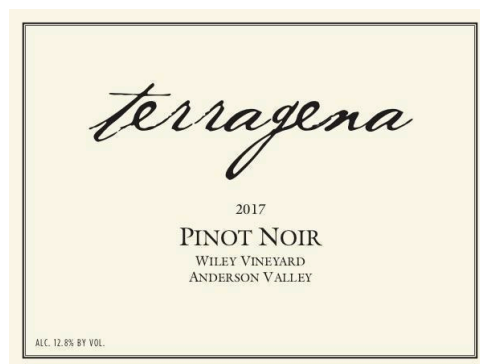
