Dear Hopewell Families: As we transition back to full-day learning, we wanted to update families on meal options. For the remainder of this school year, free meals will remain an option for all students on a pre-order basis. The cafeteria staff is working hard to fulfill pre-orders and provide the best service possible. As you may know, pre-ordered meals must be placed through the Payschools Central "myMealOrder" pre-order system. To assist you with ordering, here is a detailed description of the process. After creating an account for your children in Payschools Central, families will have the ability to pre-order lunch. After logging into Payschools, you will be able to select "**Pre-Order Meals**" in your Dashboard. This is listed in the menu on the right side of your screen. You will then complete the following:

- · Choose the meals for each of your children for the days you wish to order meals.
- Once items are added to your cart, click the **RED "Check Out"** box in the right-hand corner.
- Review your selections, and then click the **GREEN "Place Order"** box in the right-hand corner. Must complete this step
- To finalize your order, click the **ORANGE "Continue"** bar at the bottom of the page. Must complete this step.
- You will get a **BLUE** screen indicating "Success" & "a copy of your receipt will be emailed to you."
