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Present Simple - Part 1


VERB TO BE: ser, estar, tener (edad)

Verb CAN: poder

This verb should be always followed by another main verb in a sentence and it is used for all subject pronouns.

Grammar box

Affirmative structure	Negative structure
I am You are He/She/it is We/You/They are	I am not (I'm not) You (You aren't) He/She/It (He/She/It isn't) We/You/They (We/You/They aren't)
I/you/she/he/it/we/you/they CAN + verb + For example: I can cook dinner.	I/you/she/he/it/we/you/they CAN'T + verb + For example: I can't cook dinner.
Interrogative structure (Questions)	Short answers
Am I a student? Is he/she/it? Are we/you/they?	Yes, I am/No, I am not Yes, he/she/it is/No, he/she/it isn't Yes, we/you/they are/No, we/you/they aren't
CAN + I/you/she/he/it/we/you/they + Verb+? For example: Can you cook dinner?	Yes, I/you/she/he/it/we/you/they CAN No, I/you/she/he/it/we/you/they CAN'T
