- III. Why you care (objective is to get you into the room)

  - a. Add in a little bit of lit review to help people out with where you're going
- V. Lay out the question
- VI. Methods
  - a. What did you do?
  - b. How you analyzed
- VII. What did you find?
  - a. 2 or 3 graphs are plenty
  - b. IOC (Inter Ocular Trama)- do they get it?
- VIII. What it all meant?
  - a. Restate your question and *undersell*. "This one study suggests that just maybe blah blah blah happened."
  - b. Contextualize
- IX. What's next?
  - a. Basically this could possibly be related to this..
- X. Remind them who you are
  - a. Your name and email address
