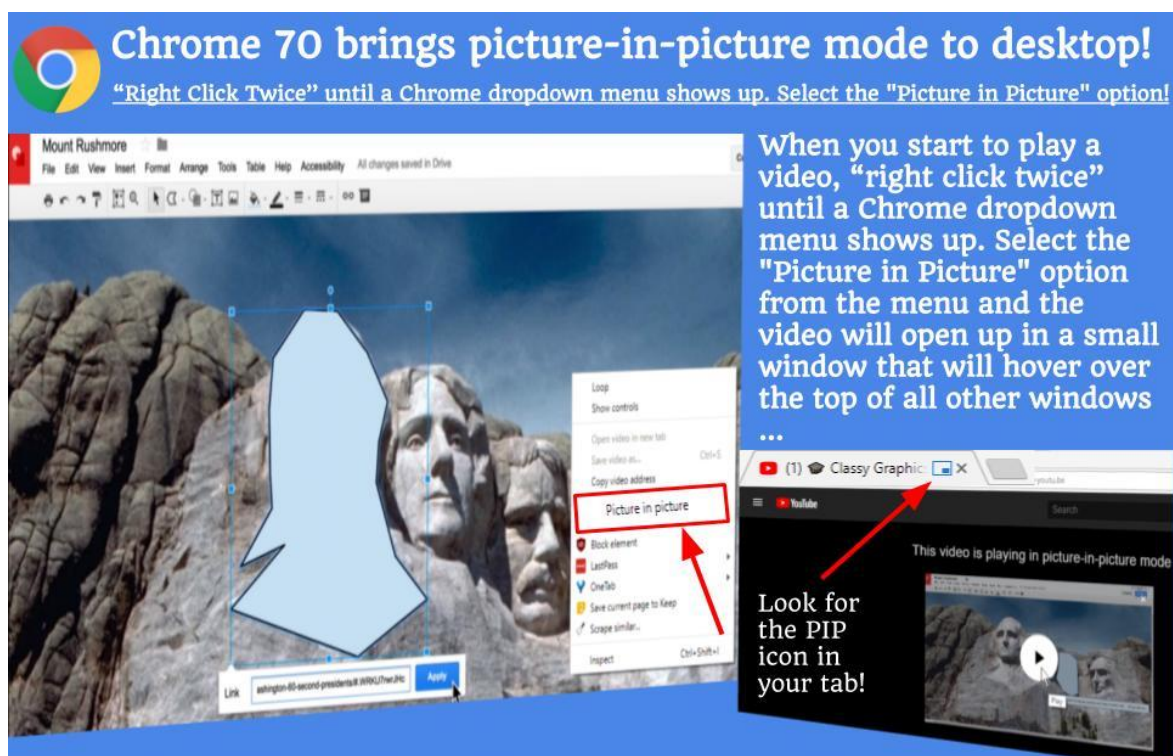

 "Right Click Twice" until a Chrome dropdown menu shows up. Select the "Picture in Picture" option!



When you start to play a video, "right click twice" until a Chrome dropdown menu shows up. Select the "Picture in Picture" option from the menu and the video will open up in a small window that will hover over the top of all other windows

Look for the PIP icon in your tab!
