- A variety of formal/informal assessment tools (e.g., rubrics, essays, conferences, journals, exams, checklists, etc.)
- Assessments and feedback provided by teachers, peers, and self
- Formative assessments throughout the project encouraging student reflection and revision
- Assessments that focus on individual accomplishment as well as on group work
