Standing Item: 211 Hannah and Kerry (15 min)	- From Shannon: Staff Performed Referral Activity Dashboard for December has been updated. An upcoming tool will be added to compare weekly and monthly progress. - From Kerry: December was slow, but was still able to attend outreach events. Noticed people in the community were familiar with 211. - Families are reaching out to 211 with different needs, including overnight care, non ERDC care, weekend infant care, and foster care child care resources. - If you want region specific narratives, reach out to Kerry.
Standing Item: ELSI Alexis and Hillary (20 min)	- From Alexis: ELSI is hiring for four different positions, they are posted on the OSU website. - From Kendall: Thank you to everyone who responded to the survey, they received 87 NAEYC Awareness survey responses. - ELSI Coaching Core Updates: 15 coaches participated in the pilot and 6 completed all 4 components. - ELSI Virtual Practice-Based Coaching Intensive: January 22-23, 2026
WINN Remediation Grant Ikaika and Betsy (15 min)	The Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation (WIIN) Grant will reduce lead in drinking water at child care and educational facilities. Funds will support remediation to decrease lead

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	hazards and the replacement of water pipes and fixtures within facilities. • Reimbursable expenses may cover remediation product installation, parts and labor, the removal and replacement of internal plumbing, faucets, drinking fountains, water filling stations, lead service lines, lead connectors, and other lead-free devices used for drinking, cooking, or preparing infant formula and food. • Participants will need to keep receipts, as it will be a reimbursement grant, and they will have to pay out of pocket. • Grant will be ongoing for two years, in a first-come first-serve system. • The application period opens tentatively February 2, 2026. • Applications can be found on the TRI website. • For more info, reach out to wiin@wou.edu.
