Summary

General Information

English for Work is a seven-course series by Cell-Ed that is designed for English Language Learners who would like to improve their workplace communication skills. There are two courses apiece for customer service, hospitality, and the restaurant industry, while a single course on interviewing completes the offerings in this series. Throughout the courses, learners listen to dialogs, such as conversations between employees and their supervisors, and they must answer comprehension questions that demonstrate their understanding of key details. Listening and reading tasks are supported throughout with content-specific vocabulary instruction and grammatical instruction, aiding learners in reaching their comprehension goals. Two lessons from the customer service courses were used for this review. The most commonly addressed English Language Proficiency Standards were 1, 8, and 10 at descriptor levels 2 and 3 (NRS 3 and 4).
