The elections will take place during the FMEQ Annual General Council on **Sunday, April 26, 2026**, which will be held in Trois-Rivières and will be accessible via Zoom if needed. On that day, candidates will be invited to present themselves to the member associations and answer their questions prior to the vote.

Please note that during the electoral period, no written, oral, or other forms of campaigning are permitted for any of the positions up for election. Candidates are responsible for **consulting the FMEQ Bylaws** for further details regarding role descriptions, required competencies, the nomination process, voting procedures, and the publication of results. By the end of the electoral period, that is, Saturday, April 11, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.:

Send an **email** to elections@fmeq.ca clearly indicating your name, your email address, your phone contact information, as well as your mailing address;

Attach to this email a **letter of candidacy, the body of which, including the salutation and closing, must not exceed 400 words**, and which will be made public by the Election Committee;

Attach to this email the **nomination form**, which will be made public by the Election Committee, the template of which is available on page four (4) of this document;

Optional – Attach an action plan of a maximum of one (1) page, **not** containing continuous text or descriptions of skills, experience, or abilities.

N.B. To complete the form template, please download this document in Word format and fill in the designated fields.
