BOARDWALK 11 KARAOKE COMPETITION — SEASON 2 OFFICIAL RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY

Contestants must be 21 years of age or older. The competition is intended for amateur singers and no entry fee is required. Contestants may enter **ONE category per qualifying night: Solo or Duet. Contestants may not compete in both categories on the same night.** Contestants who do not advance may return during a later qualifying week and compete again in either category. Both members of a Duet must register and meet all eligibility requirements. Registration is completed in person at Boardwalk 11.

2. COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition runs for seven qualifying weeks beginning August 31, 2026, followed by the Final on October 19, 2026. Competition performances take place Mondays from 8:00–10:30 PM. Contestants may enter any qualifying week prior to the Final and may perform one song per competition night. Contestants and Duets selected to advance will qualify for the Final. Once qualified, they may not compete in additional qualifying rounds.

3. SONG SELECTION

Songs must be available in the Boardwalk 11 karaoke catalog and may be changed prior to performing. Songs should be approximately five minutes or less whenever possible. Boardwalk 11 reserves the right to reject selections that are excessively long, inappropriate, or unavailable.

4. JUDGING

Advancing Solo contestants and Duets will be selected primarily by the judges based on vocal performance, stage presence, audience engagement, song interpretation, and overall entertainment value. Audience reaction may also be considered. All judging decisions are final.

5. FINAL

Qualifying Solo contestants and Duets will advance to the Final on October 19, 2026. Finalists must be present and ready to perform; failure to appear may result in disqualification. Audience participation and crowd response may play a larger role during the Final. Winners will be selected separately in the Solo and Duet categories.

6. PERFORMANCE RULES

Performances must match the category in which the contestant registered. Solo entries may only be performed by the registered Solo contestant; Duet entries may only be performed by the two registered members of that Duet. Duet partners may not be substituted after qualifying for the Final. Additional singers, backup singers, dancers, or performers are not permitted. Contestants must conduct themselves respectfully toward fellow contestants, staff, judges, and guests. Excessive intoxication, disruptive behavior, harassment, or unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification.

7. PRIZES

Solo First Prize: \$500 Cash • Duet First Prize: \$500 Cash. There are no second-place prizes.

8. GENERAL

By entering, contestants grant Boardwalk 11 permission to photograph, record, and use their name, image, and performance for promotional purposes. Boardwalk 11 reserves the right to modify competition procedures as necessary to ensure a fair and enjoyable event and has final authority regarding rule interpretations, disputes, and competition decisions.

9. CHANGES OR CANCELLATION

Boardwalk 11 reserves the right to change, postpone, suspend, or cancel the competition at any time. Management's decisions regarding the operation of the competition are final.

10. MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

Boardwalk 11 management has final authority over all competition matters, including eligibility, judging procedures, advancement, rule interpretations, disputes, and disqualifications.
