NEW BUSINESS:

- ARPA Funds-** Upon recommendation of the ARPA Allocation Committee there was a **Motion** by Clerk Olson, **Second** by Bryce Holden to allocate the remaining American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds of roughly \$4500 as follows:
 - \$350 for upgraded conference microphone speaker system to be used for meetings and a speaker for members of the public.
 - \$1000 for Keweenaw County Sheriff’s Department for Keweenaw Search and Rescue.
 - The remaining funds (roughly \$3150) allocated towards hiring an entity to develop a survey/study to collect housing data in Eagle Harbor Township for the benefit of improving knowledge of residential and business water and sewer infrastructure. Data will assist Eagle Harbor Township, EGLE and the local Health Department with approval of a possible municipal sewer system. **Roll call vote:** 4 ayes. **Motion carried.**
- BOR Appointments-Motion** by Clerk Olson, **Second** by Trustee Holden to reappoint the following current Board of Review members for a two year term: Peggy Carlson, Nancy Molloy, Ginny Schubert, and Steve Jarm. **Vote:** unanimous, **Motion carried.**
- Planning Commission Appointment-Motion** by Treasurer Asselin, **Second** by Bryce Holden to reappoint Clerk Olson as Board Liaison to the Planning Commission. **Vote:** 3 ayes, 1 Abstain. **Motion carried**
