1. Supply Status—Janet has contacted Lori T-G re: ordering 2 large dish soaps and 2 gallons of EO soap from Frontier for refill.

2. Dishwasher Oversight-- Deb spoke with Susan I. She reports the only maintenance is periodic cleaning of filters, which she hasn't needed to do—stresses importance of cleaning food from dishes before loading.

3. Recycling Update

~Metal recycling will be scheduled for first Saturday of October. **Deb** will contact company.

~CD recycling—two church members inquired recently about recycling CDs and will bring. **Team**-find dedicated boxes that were at church for CD recycling and re-place in visible locations.
