SCRIPTURE READING AND DISCUSSION (15 minutes)

Read Genesis 1:26-31, 2:8-17

Discussion Questions:

- 1. God told man to rule over certain parts of creation. Can you name the things God allowed men to rule over? (Man was to rule over the fish, birds, livestock, over all the earth & over all creatures that move along the ground.)
- 2. What did God give to man for food? (Every seed bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. He also gave man every green plant for food.)
- 3. God saw all that He had made and it was very _____? (Good)
- 4. The trees in the garden were ______ to the eye and good for _____. (Pleasing, food)
- 5. Where did God put the man He had created? (In the Garden of Eden.)
- 6. Name one of the four rivers that flowed from the Garden of Eden. (*Pishon, Gihon, Tigris & Euphrates*)
- 7. What job did God give man? (To work in the garden and take care of it.)
- 8. God told Adam and Eve that they could eat from all trees but one, which tree did God tell Adam and Eve that they could not eat from? (*The Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil.*)
- 9. How can we know the difference between good and evil? (We can know what is good or evil based on God's Word.)
