Critical Care Air Transport Initial Course (held at Wright-Patterson AFB, Dayton, Ohio) Courses run throughout the year. Course is 2 weeks in length and includes lecture hands on with all equipment and plenty of high-speed simulation. Air Force CCATT teams configured currently with a respiratory therapist, nurse (emergency or critical care), and a physician (emergency medicine, surgery, anesthesia, and critical care typically).
