
## Tops and Bottoms or Above and Below

## **Purpose:**

Watch and listen to this read aloud of <u>Tops &</u>
<u>Bottoms</u>. This story will give you many ideas of what kind of drawing you can make.





## Materials:

Paper, Pencil, Coloring Tools (optional)

## **Directions:**

- 1. Fold a piece of paper in half. One half will be "above" and the other "below".
- 2. Decide where your drawing will take place. You could choose to draw a city, a farm, the ocean, or the surface of Mars. There are so many possibilities!
- 3. Start sketching each section- Does anything go from above to below? For example, a carrot's green leaves are above the ground and the orange root is below the ground or an animal could be partially underground and partially poking up to say hello!
- 4. What story does your picture tell? What is the weather? Is there an exciting adventure taking place?
- 5. Share your artwork and story with someone in your home.

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
