Shoday, born Shodade Solomon Segun in 2000, is a Nigerian Afrobeat artist and singer-songwriter celebrated for his distinctive sound and engaging melodies. Originating from Ogun State and raised in Lagos, he developed a passion for music early on. He holds a National Diploma in Building Technology from Yaba College of Technology (YABATECH).

Shoday gained significant attention with “Dey 4 You,” which amassed over 500,000 streams on Audiomack within its first week, further amplified by promotion from renowned music producer Don Jazzy. His subsequent release, “Caution,” propelled him onto global charts, including the Nigeria Shazam Charts and Top 100 Apple Music listings, solidifying his status as a rising star in the Afrobeat genre.

In October 2024, Shoday released the single “Casablanca,” featuring Nigerian artist Ayo Maff. The track achieved remarkable success, garnering over 7 million streams on Spotify and reaching the #3 position on the Lagos Apple Music charts, Casablanca Also made it to Apple Music Best Songs of 2024

Shoday's growing prominence in the music industry is further evidenced by his signing with 5K Records, a subsidiary of Sony Music Entertainment UK Limited. This partnership has facilitated the release of his music to a broader audience, including the single "Casablanca"

As of December 2024, Shoday has accumulated over 19 million total plays on Spotify, with a monthly listenership exceeding 1 Million and a follower count of over 140,000+.

Shoday's journey from content creation to becoming a prominent figure in the Afrobeat scene underscores his talent and commitment to his art. With a steadily increasing fanbase and a series of successful releases, such as "Queen N More", "Something Something" and "Finee" he continues to captivate audiences with his engaging melodies and relatable lyrics, positioning him as one of Nigeria's promising young talents in the music industry.
