# **FCPS CAREER & TECHNICAL CENTERS**

Fayette County has historically offered three technical center options to high school students: Locust Trace, Eastside, and Southside. For the 2025-2026 school year, Eastside & Southside will be consolidating into one building called The HILL: Hub for Innovative Learning & Leadership.

An application is required for both LTAC & The HILL. If you attend a technical center, your academy pathway will be completed there. You may also choose to take one of your core classes at the technical center if you wish and as available. This will open up room for you to take an additional elective of your choosing at FDHS.

If accepted, you will spend part of your school day at the technical center and part at FDHS. Bus transportation is provided between Douglass and all technical centers.

- When choosing electives, consider the humanities requirement for graduation. This requirement can be
  completed by taking TWO classes in the same area of the arts OR by taking Visual & Performing Arts during your
  11th or 12th grade year. If you are opting to take the route of two classes in the arts, it is highly recommended
  that you start now.
- Two years (high school credits) of the same World Language are also highly suggested if you're college-bound.
