As a small school, the cohort numbers for each year group varies dramatically and in some year groups 1 child could be 25% of that year group.

Data does not reflect the groupings in a cohort such as gender, additional needs, EAL or pupils who have transferred into our school. All these groupings can affect data.

Data is always used to inform next steps in learning for individual children, groups and cohorts and, in addition, also informs areas for development on the School Improvement Plan.
