Energy Pathways Scholarship (12th grade)

These \$3000 scholarships are available to high school seniors who intend to pursue a career in a STEM field. Applicants must enroll at a Utah college or technical institute, and must write a personal essay. Italian-American Civic League (12th grade)

This \$1000 scholarship is available to high school seniors of Italian American ancestry. Two scholarships will be awarded based on ACT/SAT score, exceptional high school ability, and participation in extra-curricular activities. This scholarship worth up to \$2000 is available to high school juniors and seniors who are interested in project management. Finalists will be required to submit a transcript, and must be available to present their project April 8 and 10, 2021. This scholarship is available to seniors who are US citizens or legal residents and who plan on attending an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university, or technical college in the fall. Applicants must demonstrate financial need, and must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75. Applicants must also show leadership quality and good moral character. Applicants must submit an application, transcript and video answering the following question: "What unique perspective, passion, or curiosity drives your academic interests? How do you envision it shaping your future as a scholar and leader in your field?" Sketchers Foundation Scholarships (12th grade)
