ABSTRACT The abstract should be a concise but comprehensive reflection of what is in your article. In particular, the abstract should be without abbreviations, footnotes and references. The size of the abstract must be at least 1800 characters (including spaces). The abstract should be written in one paragraph and should not contain reflected mathematical equations or tabular material. Make sure your abstract is well-read and grammatically correct. Title must be written using Calibri 20pt, bold, center. The spacing between title and authors line is 8pt. Author's names (without affiliation) should be typed using Calibri 10pt, bold, center. Author's affiliation (department, university, city, country) should be written using 8pt, center. The spacing between authors' names and affiliation line is 3pt, also 6pt after affiliation. Please indicate the corresponding author (the Corresponding author is the person who handles the manuscript and correspondence during the publication process, including approving the article proofs) using the suggested symbol. The abstract and keywords must be written using Calibri 9pt, width. The spacing before them after the abstract is 6pt.

I. INTRODUCTION

These instructions give you guidelines for preparing documents for Security of Infocommunication Systems and Internet of Things. In order of effect high quality of your article please use this MS Word template for preparing your paper submission. Do not adjust any margins, fonts, etc. The article should be at least 4 pages, including figures, references, a short autobiography of the authors and information about the article in Ukrainian.

The paper should be prepared using A4 paper format. Mirror margins: upper – 20 mm, lower – 20 mm, inside – 20 mm, outside – 20 mm. Page header 15 mm, footer 15 mm – different odd and even, different first page. Two columns – width 82.5 mm, spacing 5 mm, no line between. The text after the chapter title begins with 5 mm indent. The main text of the paper should be written in Times New Roman 10 points, single spacing, without automatic hyphenation. However, for the captions of all sections (chapter title), subsections, tables "**TABLE**" and figures "**FIG.**" use the Calibri font, bold. The space between last section and next section title should be 6pt, between section title and subsection should be 3pt.

A. Subsections style. Subsections should be numbered alphabetically.

B. Subsections font. The title of the divisions is Calibri 10pt, width.

II. EQUATIONS

Equations should be written in Microsoft Equation. Equations should be centered and labelled. The example of equation is Eq. 1

$$i = C \frac{dU_C}{dt} \quad (1)$$

Larger equation must be split in multiple lines.

III. FIGURES AND TABLES

Tables should be made as one column. In rare case it allowed to use two column tables at the top of the page. Tables must have caption located above the table. Table captions should be written using 9pt Calibri font.

Figures also should be one column wide. If it is impossible using two column wide figures is allowed but in that case figure must be located at the top of the page. All figures must be stored in *.jpg, *.tif or *.bmp formats with the minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Each figure must have a caption under the figure. For figure captions 9pt should be used.

Figures and tables must be centered in the column. Large figures and tables may span across both columns. Any table or figure that spans two columns must be positioned either at the top or at the bottom of the page. All figures and tables must be referenced in the text.




FIG. 1. Example of an image with acceptable resolution.




