Each card should include -

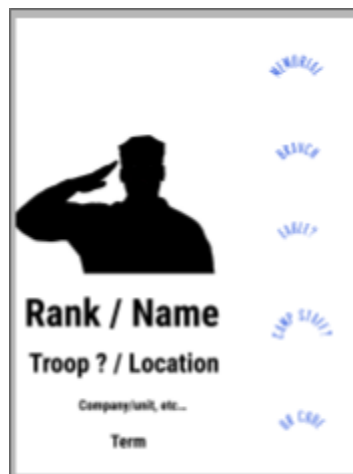
- Photo in either military or scout uniform

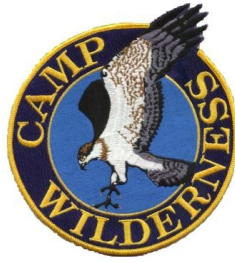

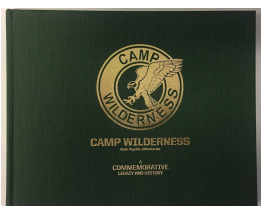

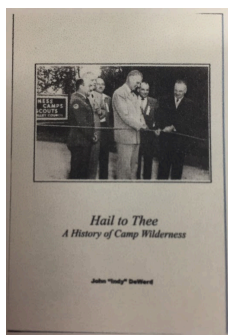
