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For an obscure character in the Bible he left us with some invaluable information.

Agur = collector or gatherer. And if we are gathering or collecting from the scriptures we too will have some priceless info. The true knowledge of God is not acquired by passive meditation or religious activity. But it can be imparted by God's Spirit to a humble mind and believing heart when searching the scriptures.

Let's see what he wrote in Proverbs 30.

He shows honest self- abasement when it comes to spiritual knowledge.

Proverbs 30:2 Surely I *am* more brutish than *any* man, and have not the understanding of a man.

Proverbs 30:3 I neither learned wisdom, nor have the knowledge of the holy.

As a natural man we are incapable of understanding spiritual truth.

1 Corinthians 2:14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

Jesus told his disciples that he had other things for them but they weren't capable of receiving them UNTIL the Holy Spirit came.

John 16:12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.

John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

And the Apostle Paul stated **1 Corinthians 3:18** Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise.

And though he (Agur) was doltish own eyes about his spiritual discernment he had more than many theologians and educators today. Which wouldn't know the truth of the Godhead from lies of the devil.

Agur knew a Creator and sustainer of the universe has a son. And that he ascended into heaven and descended. And that he controls the winds, established the ends of the earth. And then the Holy Spirit dropped us the Son's name.

I reckon when we are willing to think soberly (not highly of ourselves) God is ready to open our understanding of His work and person.

Agur said: **Proverbs 30:5** Every <u>word of God</u> *is* pure: <u>he</u> *is* a shield unto them that put their trust in <u>him</u>.

And then gives a personal attribute to the word of God – "<u>he</u> is a shield unto them that put their trust in <u>him</u>." It is as if he knew what God would reveal about Jesus Christ when he said **Revelation 19:13** And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and <u>his name</u> is called <u>The Word of God</u>.

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Who said: "Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Lest I be full, and deny *thee*, and say, Who *is* the LORD? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God *in vain*."
