PSEO To Do List Prior to January 29th Meeting

1. Check to see if you are eligible

Each college sets their own requirements for PSEO students. Research to make sure you meet the PSEO requirements of the college you wish to apply to by going to their website. Below is Anoka Ramsey's criteria, for example:

- High School Sophomores: Must pass 8th grade MN Comprehensive Assessment (MCA)
 Reading at the composite proficiency level of "meets or exceeds", or equivalent
 assessment, and meets the prerequisites of the CTE course they wish to enroll in.
- High School Juniors: Must be in the upper one-third of class or test score at or above
 the 70th percentile on any nationally standardized, norm-referenced test such as the
 ITED, PLAN, ACT, PSAT or CAT (Timed Version). Juniors may also qualify with an
 unweighted HS GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- High School Seniors: Must be in the upper one-half of class or test score at or above 50th percentile on any nationally standardized, norm-referenced test such as the ITED, PLAN, ACT, PSAT or CAT (Timed Version). Seniors may also qualify with a High School GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- **2.** In January, register for a full load of classes here at CRHS for next year. It is far easier for us to drop your classes than register for them at the last minute if your plans change.
- 3. Attend the required PSEO Informational Meeting on Thursday, January 29th, 2026 at 4:30pm in the auditorium during Parent Teacher conferences (families are welcome to attend). If you are unable to attend you must watch the recording on a later date.
- 4. After attending the January meeting (or watching the recording) contact your counselor to finalize the PSEO paperwork prior to the May 30th deadline.
