

Year 6 Planner – The Highwayman

Topic (Geography and history)

In Topic we will be learning about highwaymen as well as crime and punishment in the 18th century. We will look at the stories and legends of infamous highwaymen and highwaywomen from different countries.

English

In English we will begin our topic by writing a narrative poem in the style of Alfred Noyes and 'The Highwayman'. We will observe features of poetry including repetition, onomatopoeia and rhyme. We will also write different texts that are linked to the poem; including letters, newspapers and character descriptions.

Czech

V prvním termu se zaměříme na opakování učiva čtvrté třídy. Budeme se zabývat stavbou souvětí, procvičovat pravidla shody přísudku s podmětem, určovat vzory podstatných jmen. Čeká nás určování slovních druhů, rozlišování předpon a předložek, hláskové skupiny ě, je, mě, mně. V literatuře a slohu budeme číst zajímavá vypravování a popisy a následně tvořit své vlastní texty. V hodinách vlastivědy se zaměříme na podrobnou charakteristiku ČR (povrch, vodstvo, zemědělství, těžký a spotřební průmysl) včetně práce s mapou a orientace v ní. Povíme si také více o době po bitvě na Bílé hoře a vládě Habsburků.

Mathematics

In Maths we will begin with ensuring that we have grasped the basics of number and place value in large numbers as well as decimals before moving onto calculating using all four operations. We will continue to develop our times tables skills and arithmetic skills.

Science

We will begin by carrying out investigations linked to our Highwayman crime scene and later in the term move on to learning the unit of 'Living Things and Their Habitats'. We will be able to describe how living things are classified into groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. As well as give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

Physical Education

Students will do multiple activities like athletics, small sided games leading to invasion games and basic fundamental movement skills (FMS).

Computing

We will begin the year with refreshing our typing skills using TypingClub and after a few weeks we will take a break to recap Internet Safety SMART rules. We will end the term with a topic on 3D design and 3D printing.

Art

We will be using water colours to create images from the poem 'The Highwayman' using the similes and metaphors to explore the setting. We will also learn how to use sketching pencils correctly for shading and observational drawings.

PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education)

Our focus will be settling into Year 6 and starting their new journey in Valdštejnska. We will also discuss the importance of kindness and respect towards others through our class text 'Wonder'.
