Key Takeaways

- The proposal to change the U.S. Freestyle Ski National Championships format passed with a 8-2 vote
- Changes aim to align with Olympic pathways and performance-based qualification.
- Key amendments were made to clarify language and address concerns raised during discussion
- Implementation will require clear communication to stakeholders and careful consideration of impacts

Topics

Proposal Overview and Background

- Proposal designed by Matt Gnoza and National Office, passed Moguls Subcommittee 8-2
- Driven by need to align with Olympic criteria and ensure fair, performance-based pathways
- Changes qualification process and event structure to mirror Olympic format (Q1, Q2, F1, F2, F3)
- No changes to existing qualification criteria for Nationals; focuses on event format once there

Qualification Process

- Top 16 U.S. athletes from NORAM overall Grand Prix standings qualify
- Top 8 U.S. athletes from World Cup overall standings pre-seeded to finals
- Next 30 ranked U.S. athletes from FSP moguls and duals lists qualify
- Divisional allocations and Junior Nationals qualifiers remain unchanged
- Total field size remains approximately 60 athletes (plus or minus)

New Event Format

- Pre-seeded athletes (top 8 from Overall World Cup and NorAm standings) go directly to finals
- Q1 and Q2 rounds for remaining athletes, with top 8 from each advancing to finals



- Finals will include 32 athletes (16 pre-seeded, 8 from Q1, 8 from Q2,)
- Dual moguls will use top 40 from moguls results (including Q rounds) for entry and seeding

Concerns and Discussion Points

- Mid-season change causing potential disruption to athlete travel plans and reservations
- Questions about the necessity of format change for this season
- Debate over the benefits of multiple qualification rounds vs. single run format
- Clarification needed on language for odd-number allocations and overall standings references

Amendments to Proposal

- 1. Clarify that extra spots from uneven numbers will go to Q2 round
- 2. Add "overall" to World Cup and NORAM Cup standings references
- 3. Strike language about top 60 requirement, as it's no longer relevant

FSC Vote on Proposal

- 10 of 13 FSC Members in attendance in the meeting tonight. Quorum
- The vote total was 8 Member Vote For the Proposal with amendments, 2 member votes against the proposal with amendments.
- Totals included Thom Schafer documented voted yes, Ali Kariotis documents voted yes.

Next Steps

- Matt Gnoza to update proposal document with agreed amendments
- Circulate updated proposal through communication channels to divisions and programs
- Begin discussions with Moguls Subcommittee about selection process for next season
- Develop clear, professional communication strategy for stakeholders
- Address foreign athlete seeding into qualifier rounds
- Implement changes for upcoming U.S. Freestyle Ski National Championships

Action Items

- Update proposal doc add "overall" to pre-seed criteria, extra spots to Q2, strike #6 re top 60
- Follow up w/ Charles (Canadian team) about NORAM events refund policies
- Circulate updated proposal thru all communication channels to divisions/programs
- Start MSC convo about 2025 U.S. Selections event
