Pizza	\$216	Assumes we get pizza for three events, and we have about 30 attendees total per event. At 3 normal-sized slices per, we would need about 2 extra larges (cheese and pepperoni) and 2 small (gluten-free and vegan). We would have to pick up the pizza from Bazbeaux
Marketing materials	\$144	8.5x11 posters for advertising events, printed from Campus Impressions. Assumes 120 total over course of year. Also includes 3 large banners for tabling events.
