#### **Statements from Parishioners**

• Church was beautifully decorated. Decorations will stay up until February 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Presentation of the Lord.

## Faith formation/Education

- Faith Formation:
  - Forty to fifty kids are enjoying what is presented each week.
- Sacred Heart School:
  - o Students really like their teachers.
  - School will send out packets of raffle tickets to all parishioners to purchase.
  - Open house at school coming up.
    - May want to have a wine tasting as one event.
    - May want to make this a parish wide event.
- First Reconciliation on Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, was well received.
- Maybe only three for First Communion.

## **Building and Grounds**

- Rail in choir loft: Mike Roberts and Clifford Nankervis are in the process of installing metal posts with wire connecting to each post.
- Ice build-up over side entrance: May want to blow insulation in roof.
- Ladies who decorate want to hang some pictures in the basement and would like the rail moved down. It was decided that Clifford would get more information from Mary Ann.
- There is a need for additional electrical outlets in the basement. Will have to get a quote.

### Finance:

- Weekly contribution down 20%
- UPCSA 80.7% of total SH parish will need to make up the difference. SH only had 54 contributors which is only 27% of our parish.
- Request to add something to online streaming slide show to remind people to donate.

#### **Old Business:**

- SH Retreat discussion:
  - Year of the Eucharist. Fr. Corey will put on a 3-4 hour retreat at St. Ann's on a Saturday with a luncheon. He will invite other priests in to assist due to confessions.
  - Lent starts on February 22.

  - o All churches invited January 14th at 8:00 am
  - o Fr. Corey will give a presentation on brotherhood.

### **New Business**

- Eucharistic Ministers:
  - SH needs EMCs as some of the ones who serve are unable due to infirmity. Tom Kurkowski said he is willing to be a sub; John will talk to Lois Kemppainen for setting up training.
  - Fr. Corey mentioned that the Bishop has asked lay people to be EMCs.
