2026-2027 Incoming Full Day Kindergarten Students

Verification of Residency and Enrollment

Welcome to Lake Forest School District 67! Please start your [Pre-Registration](#) process for your incoming kindergarten student; you will need to submit your verification of residency and enrollment electronically when submitting online pre-registration. *(The District will offer a half-day program if a minimum of 20 parents apply, as per School Code 105 ILCS 5/10-22.17.)*

Next steps for Registration: Lake Forest SD 67 CANNOT approve your student’s pre-registration until you have provided the necessary documentation to verify residency and enrollment. Once your pre-registration is approved, families will receive a SnapCode email in mid-May with instructions on how to complete the registration process and pay school fees for the 2026-2027 school year.

Please submit the following FOUR items:

- **Certified, Original Birth Certificate**
- **Proof of Residency** (see requirements below)
 - In situations where you currently own or rent a home within Lake Forest, you must provide documentation showing you reside at the address provided on your pre-registration form. **You must provide one (1) document from Category A and two (2) documents from Category B. Proof of residency applies to any incoming student, even if a sibling currently attends one of District 67's schools.**

- In situations where you are under contract on a home within Lake Forest, your child is permitted to begin school provided you will purchase a home within 90 days after your child begins school at District 67. **You must complete a non-resident tuition agreement and provide a check for \$6,701.62** per student. Once you purchase the home, you must provide documentation of residency and your nonresident tuition check will be returned. If you do not purchase the home and provide residency documentation within 90 days after your child begins school at District 67, your nonresident tuition check will be cashed and you must provide another check for \$5,883.41 per student.
- In situations where you reside with other family members, such as a grandparent, the person who owns the residence must complete a **Property Owner Verification** form, and the parent/guardian must complete an **Affidavit of Residence** form. These forms will be provided upon request.
