- 1. Exodus 2:24 says that God "remembered His covenant with Abraham..." What does this mean? What does it mean for God to remember the New Covenant poured out in Jesus' blood (1 Corinthians 11:25)?
- 2. Moses raises four objections before asking God to send another. What is the common element of God's responses to Moses' objections? What does this suggest about the result of God's ultimate plan to be known among the nations (Revelation 21:3)?
- 3. Read Matthew 28:16-20. What hope do we have for the success of our mission? How can we practically rely on that hope?

## **Last Week - September 12, 2021 (Exodus 1:1-2:10)**

- 1. What role does fear play in the unfolding story of Exodus 1:1-2:10? What are some of the different objects of fear and results of acting on that fear?
- 2. How has fear of the "other" manifested in your life? What does Exodus 1 have to say about that fear?
- 3. Read Matthew 2:13-18. What parallels do you see between the early life of Moses and the early life of Jesus?
