Immunization Documentation Requirements

Under the California Health and Safety Code, Sections 120325-120380, children in California are required to receive certain immunizations at a given age to attend public and private elementary and secondary schools, child care centers, nursery schools, and developmental centers.

Live Oak Waldorf School is required to enforce immunization requirements, maintain immunization records of all children enrolled, and submit annual reports.

Immunization Records must be on file and meet the age-appropriate vaccine requirements before the first day of school.

Enrollment Requirements

To promptly enroll a new student, Live Oak Waldorf School requires submission of **one** of the following documents **prior to the student's start date**:

1. A copy of the student's most recent immunization record. Please ensure the vaccines listed meet the immunization requirements for the grade you are applying for.
2. A fully completed and signed personal belief exemption or medical exemption transferred to Live Oak Waldorf in a cumulative file (CUME) or faxed to us directly from a previous school or child care center. Exemptions transferred from other schools only apply to students enrolled in schools prior to January 1, 2016.
3. A medical exemption is issued through the CAIR-ME Registry.
