Rules/Instructions:

We will be escorted by emergency vehicles throughout the route until we get to Holly Road.

We ask that you drive one of the three ways at the stop sign. (Left to Mitchell St., Right on Holly, or straight to Granite) Mrs. Nimcheski will be there to direct traffic.

Please do not toss candy or items from the vehicles so our families who come out to watch are not put in danger.

Please wave from your cars and honk your horns to support each and every graduate in the parade.

Follow all driving laws once you get past Holly Road. (If you drive down Mitchell, follow the rules of the road.)

Graduates: Put your name on your car and decorate - Go Vikings! One Graduate per Vehicle Unless you have multiple graduates in your family. You are encouraged to have a parent or responsible driver drive you while you can enjoy the parade route.

Family / Spectator Parking: The route is 1.8 Miles that winds around the walking trail and past many public parking spots. We encourage families to practice social distancing while spectating. There is more than enough space to cover this expectation.
