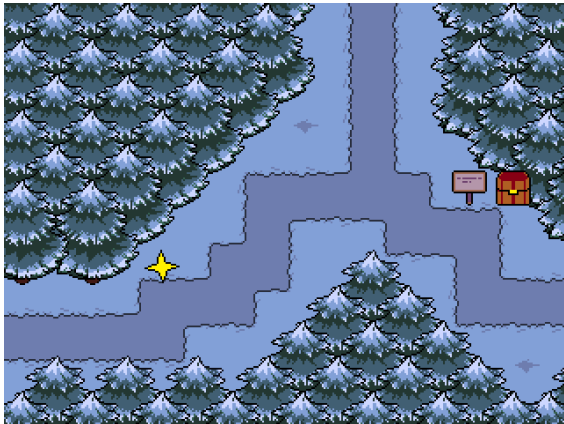


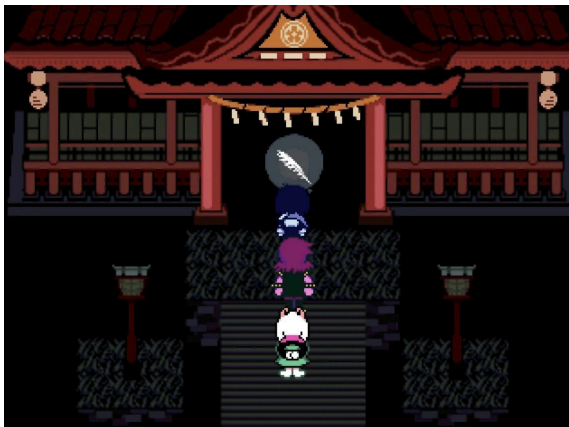
REVERSE UNDERTALE THEORY (PART 4.5: CHAPTER 5 PREDICTIONS)



Welcome. Chapter 5 is set to release June 24th of 2026 and I am typing the majority of this as of the 11th.

GENERAL PREDICTIONS





Let's start with the tone of Chapter 5. It's been described as one last fun adventure before the sun completely sets and the story goes all in on wrapping things up with a more serious tone, basically bittersweet. That already sounds quite reminiscent of Snowdin to me, which would naturally be where the main Flower King dark world of Chapter 5 falls into this theory. To me the overall tone of Snowdin is cheerful, silly, and hopeful with undertones of sadness and despair. Everyone puts on a fake smile because it's all they believe they can and should do when they're forever trapped underground. Sans and Papyrus are comic relief but at the same time Sans has given up on his goals of going back to where he came from and Papyrus will stop at nothing to achieve his goal of getting people to look up to and respect him. Also the track "Shop 3" is of course equivalent to "Shop." Aside from the tone, I believe the light world Festival section will parallel Snowdin Town. The date with Berdly will be like the Papyrus date, and despite it not being at that specific part of the story the ice cream stand by Sans is a clear callback. With the dark world itself a garden or swamp is similar enough to a forest, and if the theory that Noelle's house will become a second dark world is true it would help with the winter theming but at the same time I'm very iffy on it. Maybe we'll at least go to the house normally at some point. The shrine we saw in the trailer will be parallel to the console exclusive dog shrine stuff underneath Papyrus's sink, or just the skeleton brothers' house in general. The most frequent visitors of the dog shrine were Sans and Mad Mew Mew, a smiling figure and a cat. Sound familiar?

SANS, RUDY, THE PURPLE FLOWER, AND FRIEND WILL ALL PARALLEL SANS IN SOME WAY



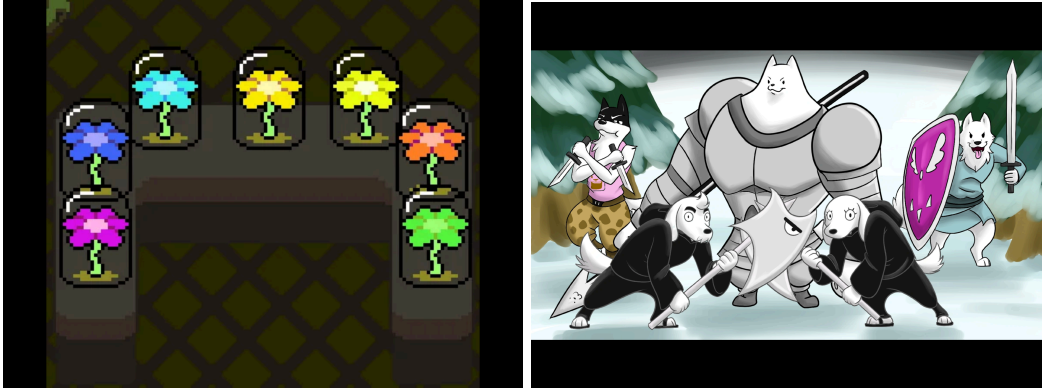
Sans because Sans, FRIEND and Rudy are fairly simple too. FRIEND is mysterious, has a creepy smile, and likes to tease us. Rudy is a jokester and could be considered as part of a duo with Asgore like how Sans is with Papyrus. Also Rudy has a dialogue sound indicating he'll be very important at some point. Why the purple flower? Well otherwise the number of flowers wouldn't fit and it would have to parallel Glyde or something who I don't see getting a parallel as So Sorry didn't in Chapter 3 nor do I see how it could be fitting (Asgore's TV as Glyde or even another skeleton brother parallel? Idk kinda doubt it). Purple because it's closest to pink with the whole pink and gold theming, really could be any flower. Yellow or cyan flowers also work 'cause of the genocide eyes.

BERDLY, ASGORE, THE GOLDEN FLOWER, AND THE KNIGHT WILL ALL PARALLEL PAPYRUS IN SOME WAY



I already explained Berdly with his date portion. Asgore because he talks to and possibly gets tricked by flowers as well as being dead set on achieving his goals. The Knight because ~~they are Papyrus~~ they have a similar body shape and will likely continue to antagonize us this chapter. The golden flower because due to all the marketing surrounding it and the importance of it being the same color flower as Flowey I believe it will be the main almost-darkner silly mascot of the chapter we'll spend the most time with in a similar fashion to Lancer, Queen, Tenna and Gerson. It could be like the Lancer to Asgore's King I think.

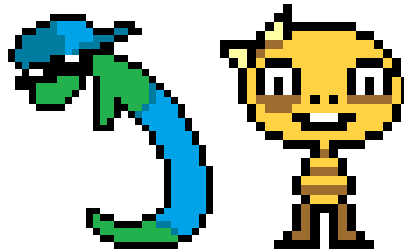
THE REST OF THE FLOWERS WILL PARALLEL THE ROYAL GUARD DOGS

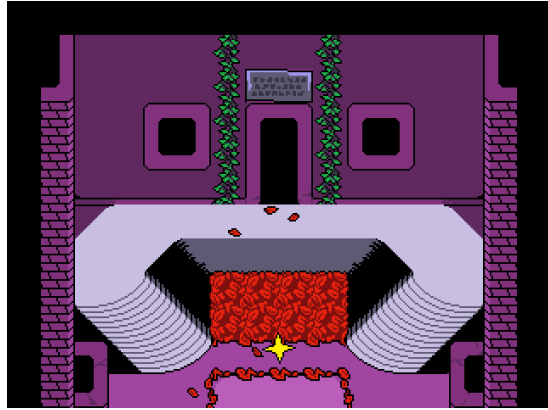
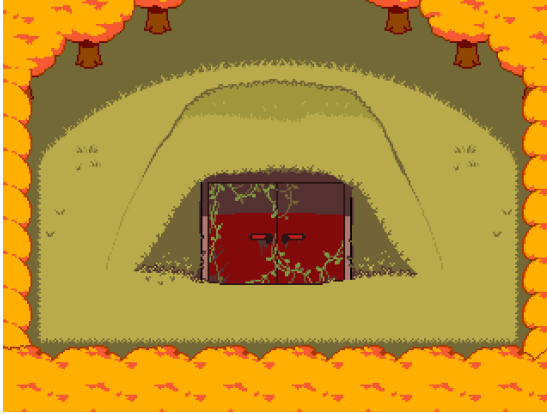
If you cut out the skeleton brother parallels the amount of flowers left, five of seven, lines up. Also I believe that outside of the royal guard dogs and the skeleton brothers the flowers will also parallel the fallen human souls, Dreemurrs, and Holidays all at once which actually aids this dog theory quite a bit. Sans and Papyrus and Kris and Asriel are siblings, Doggo and Toriel are both oblivious to things in different ways, Lesser Dog and Greater Dog are related in a way like Noelle and Dess, and the Dogi are a couple like Rudy and Carol. Unfortunately it's pretty hard to pin down soul traits and specific flowers... so I'm not going to.

JOCKINGTON WILL PARALLEL MONSTER KID



There's no hard evidence for Jockington being in this dark world but he's got a talk sprite and doesn't originate from Undertale so he's gotta show up at some point right? At least one unskippable cutscene where he speaks, maybe at the festival or something. It didn't happen in Chapter 4 like I originally thought but the parallels are too on the nose for it to not happen at all, Snowdin is the only place left where Monster Kid appears. I said this with my 3+4 predictions but I'll say it again: "young characters who speak in 'cool' lingo, worship a 'cool' girl, and have no dialogue sound nor do they have arms." (Edit: Jockington grew the beard... he does something of significance in this chapter kind of...)

ENDING PREDICTION



The shelter dark world has gotta parallel the Ruins, place literally looks like it's in Ruins, is at the edge of town, and has leaves growing around it. Not gonna go in depth since this isn't about Chapter 6 but I think Catti will parallel Napstablook, Carol will parallel Toriel, and I could see anyone who resides in the shelter as a parallel to Flowey. Just saying all this in case there's any implications in favor of these thoughts.
