Nov: Staff the district's or council's Cub Fun Day so the Cubs can earn their Target and Range awards. Cheerfully encourage and guide them.

Dec: Lead by example by earning your Religious Emblem, Outdoor Ethics Awareness Award, Outdoor Ethics Action Award, etc.

FYI: AoLs are typically choosing a Troop and crossing over Jan-Apr. Prepare them well in advance for the Summer Camp costs and logistics.
