IMPORTANT:

May 2-6-ACT Aspire State Testing for grades 3-5.

• I share these dates in advance to ask you to PLEASE keep from scheduling doctor/dental appointments, and even consider limiting your child's after school activities during these testing weeks. Research shows that getting enough rest, having a good breakfast and a scheduled routine help students perform better on state standardized tests. In addition, students who are absent during the test do not perform as well on make up tests. At Collegeville, we know students are much more than a test score. Teachers know your child's strengths and weaknesses and work diligently to make sure each child is successful. We use these tests as a diagnostic for improving instruction and providing remediation. However, the reality is also that these tests are a reflection of our school for state ratings, for state funding, and other state requirements, so all we ask is your help to do everything in our power to set students up for success.
