- MVT (Math Vertical Team) met with teachers, specialists, administrators to gather and collaborate on best practices in math education from moving from Math in Focus to REVEAL Math
- Teachers from all schools met to review and figure out problems that everyone can access, process and use analytical thinking. Asks the kids to reflect on the reasoning and how they got to the answers
- Working to get the kids engaged and curious
- Reveal Math is to teach alternate ways to get to the answer that may be available for all learners

There's some operational items that have to be addressed first, the playground and roof needs to be fixed first before this can be installed, hopeful that in the fall this should be able to be installed at outdoor classroom and the playground-It's still happening!
- Supply kits are coming back to NPE-Working with a vendor who will supply order starting 6/1-Prices will vary by grade depending on what kit needs what supplies, not mandatory but it is out there as an option. Will be delivered to the school (if they miss the window, the kits are free).

- Is there any teacher who might want to work with the kids around a theater club at NPE? We will need to look at the Bylaws to see if there's anything PTO can help with here
