Reteaching

Define and model literary analysis; explicitly teach steps; essay genre and evidence differs

Practice analysis together (reading responses throughout unit match the assessment at the end)

Feedback on that element alone

1. Feedback on personal essays as formative assessment
 - Celebrate as a whole class
 - Things to work on
 - Self grade
 - Give you another chance
2. Identify ideas/skills (character conflict) in short story
 - exemplar on "Rubiaux Rising"
3. Practice analysis with "Rubiaux Rising"
 - summarize what is happening in the book
 - select evidence (quotes) as their nightly readings

- explain what the quote means

4. Conflict Essay

- Have evidence, clarification, justification
- Thesis sentence frames
