Expenditure made up of school activities and special project (outdoor gym equipment) Main expenses are online ticketing and sales portals – we do review these time to time. Ticket Tailor have changed their fee structure – we will be passing those on to customers now. This will be reviewed regularly.

School core expenditure £16,250
Project – well being area for children £5,750
Total Budgeted Income £22,000
Budgeted Income £28,300
Projected Surplus £6,300

This year's budget is the same as last year's – taking into account rise in the cost of living.
