

CITY OF ODEBOLT – Special Meeting

April 22, 2024 – Odebolt City Hall., 6:00 P.M.

Mayor Bengford called the meeting to order with the following Council in attendance: Seth Duff, Drew Stuhrenberg, Levi Thies via phone 6:04pm-6:05PM and Ron Sorensen. Absent: Hemer. Also present: Supt. Michael Grote, City Clerk Christina Hoefling, and Joan & Dennis Jenkins.

Motion to approve the agenda was made by Duff and seconded by Stuhrenberg. Three ayes. Mayor Bengford opened the hearing at 6:03PM for Budget FY25. Zero person present in protest and zero written objections. Mayor Bengford closed the hearing at 6:04pm.

Res. 24.31 Approve Budget FY25. Motion was made by Sorensen and seconded by Duff to approve the Budget for FY25. Roll Call: Duff, Stuhrenberg, Thies, Sorensen. Absent: Hemer. Total budget taxation per \$1,000 valuation is \$13.86806. Full and complete resolution is available at City Hall.

Discussion on Dennis Jenkins having a hoop building on his property on N Main. Dennis stated is would be no bigger than 20x30 but probably 14x32 and 12ft peak. It will have reinforcements on each corner and the ends will be closed. Mayor Bengford stated that all properties that they have are very nicely kept, just worry it will open up a can of worms for others. Council agreed. but feel that he should be able to have it since he will have the extra reinforcements. Dennis said that he would fill out a permit once he finalizes things.

Unfinished business: Mayor Benford gave an update on Gritten property that it will be delayed a few months and he has started to clean up the property as well currently. Council would like to see nuisances pursued on houses that have holes in roof like one on Willow, house across from city hall, one off the Blvd., one on Odebolt St and one on Lincoln in which the chimney is about to fall.

Motion was made by Sorensen and seconded by Duff to adjourn at 6:33pm. Three ayes.
