

SAE Area: Agricultural Education

Description: Relates to education and extension, including, but not limited to youth mentoring, agricultural education departmental assistants, PALS mentors and student coordinators, developing and conducting informational materials and presentations for civic organizations and school-aged youth, and students who are involved in SAEs surrounding educating the public about the broad topics of agriculture, agriculture education and the FFA.

Project Ideas:

- Conduct and coordinate a horse safety camp.
- Plan and implement a hands-on livestock field trip.
- Lead a farm safety program for elementary students.
- Create classroom materials and activities.
- Prepare a food safety information kit covering safe handling of meat, eggs, and other fresh food products.
- Provide outdoor educational materials at local camps.
- Complete a report on 10 food plants that includes origins, uses, and cultivation practices.
- Provide email training to producers over technology use.
- Conduct a field demonstration on GPS systems for elementary students.
- Create a teaching model to show how a small gas engine works.
