

Field Day 2024 Station Directions

Station 1: Egg Spoon Race

Equipment: 4 Spoons, 4 eggs (one per team), Station Sign

Directions: Each team must carry their egg on their spoon from the starting line to a turnaround point and back again. Then, the egg is passed off to a teammate who takes their turn. If the egg is dropped, the player must stop and retrieve it. The first team to complete the relay wins.



Station 2: Obstacle Course


Equipment: Obstacle Course, Station Sign

Directions: Students will be in 2 separate lines. Students will be directed to line up at one of the starting lines. They will be racing through an identical obstacle course. **One Student from each line will complete the obstacle at a time.**

Station 3: Sack Race

Equipment: 1 Burlap Sack, Cones, Station Sign

Directions: Each player puts both legs into a sack and hops down and around the finish line cone, and back, tagging the next person in line. Then, the next person in line gets into the sack and repeats down and around the cone course. The first team to the finish line wins.



Station 4: Drip Drop Drench

Equipment: Bucket of Water, Sponge, Station Sign

Directions: Have everyone sitting in a circle. One person is it, with a wet sponge. They will walk around the circle dripping water on everyone's head while saying drip. Once the player has chosen a person, they will yell drop and squeeze the entire sponge on their head. The player who just got dropped on, must chase them around the circle and catch them before they find an open spot. **** Game is similar to Duck, Duck, Goose****

Station 5: Snack

Equipment: 4 tables, 6 chairs, edible snacks Tent, Station Sign

Directions: Students will get snacks. Snacks cannot leave this station.

Station 6: Face Painting

Equipment: Face Paint materials, 4 tables, 6 chairs, Tent, Station Sign

Directions: Students will get their face painted

Station 7: Moon Bounce

Equipment: Moon Bounce, Station Sign

Directions: Free time for students to play in the moon bounce ***NO SHOES AND ADHERE TO CHILD NUMBER LIMIT IN MOON BOUNCE***

Station 8: Dunk Tank

Equipment: Dunk tank

Directions: There will be a staff/Volunteer sitting inside of the dunk tank. Have students stand in a line and take turns to try and throw the ball at the target.
