6. Seal of Time (Cia and Lana, Goron)
7. Curse of Light (Curse itself won't end until Zelda has been impregnated)

Ancient Hylia Curses, Major

Seal of the Champion

Epona the Squire

~~Hylia cursed the Champion's squire by turning her into the first mare.~~

- ~~● **Who:** Epona and her incarnations~~
- ~~● **Curse:** turned into a horse~~
- ~~● **How the curse is undone:** Turned back into a humanoid.~~

Comrade in arms

One of the champion's most devout soldiers who also became his lover. She was always by his side. Hylia turned her into his shadow. The years of being a shadow would drive her to madness and over the centuries she would try to kill the reincarnations of the champion in order to free herself from her curse.

- **Who:** The Champion's Squire
- **Curse:** Turned into the Champions shadow
- **How the curse is undone:** Link must go to the place the squire was originally turned into the champions shadow. Link obtains another tablet piece that depicts the Squire being turned into the shadow. He also recognizes the spot, a muddy pond with a gnarled

tree in the center. Link goes there and has to mud wrestle the reformed shadow mud squire. Link eventually rips her from the muddy pool, revealing a hylian woman with Pink hair.

Curse of the Split Sword

~~After the champions creation, both the Goddess Hylia and Malika gifted their new champion a sword each. The champion, not sure which one to use over the other, used his impressive power to simply force them together into one sword. After "lunking" it, the new sword became sentient and took on the name Fahira. When the Goddess Hylia tricked Malika into the demon realm, she ripped the swords into two again and gave what would be known as Chirahim to Malika while the champion kept the goddess's blade which became Fi. Since this ancient separation both swords have been reforged in different ways:~~

- ~~● **Who:** Fi and Chirahim~~
- ~~● **Curse:** Split from each other by Hylia~~
- ~~● **How the curse is undone:** Fi only required Chirahim to touch the handle of the master sword to initiate the refusion. Once she has a connection she will download herself into Chirahim and appear to take over.~~

Seal of Fairies

Fairies

The Great Fairies were the first to grow romantically involved with the champion, since they worked so closely together. There were five great fairies; Magic, Courage, Wisdom, Power, and Kindness. Hylia forbade and cursed them from having relations with the Champion. All of the great fairies over the course of the centuries and the last great war have died off. New ones must be found to take their place and in order to break the seal all of them must be impregnated by Link.

Seal of Shadows

The Sheikah and the Twili

Hylia originally altered a small sect of Hylians into the Shekiah to serve her. Like many of the goddesses creations, she decided to make only female sheikah. Eventually she gave them one male, the Champion. The Sheikah were originally either ninjas or sorceress's, both with their respective leader with the champion promised as a consort to each leader. But as Hylia grew more and more jealous of the attention the Champion was giving to other women, she would forbid all Sheikah from having relations with the champion. The ninja clan Sheikah did not take any action against the goddess's wishes but the sorceresses did. Hylia would banish them to

the twilight realm for daring to oppose her and this betrayal of her most loyal servants set the foundation for a much darker curse on the goddess herself.

- **Who:** Impa and Midna
- **Curse:** Not technically not a curse, but a broken oath that Zelda must fulfill
- **How the curse is undone:** Impa and Midna

Seal of Water and Wind

The Queen of the Water

There were four hylian fishing women that fell in love with the Champion. The Champion, fearing for their safety and that of his unborn children, gave each one a magical stone to hide their pregnancies. Sadly, this was not enough and Hylia found out. She cursed the four women and their descendants to be fish and hylian hybrids, thus creating the Zora. To add further insult, the goddess also cursed the four women to forever need to wear the stones given to them by the champion. Otherwise they would turn into “the fat fish they where” and expand uncontrollably.

- **Who:** Zora Queens
- **Curse:** Turned into Zora and will expand uncontrollably without smooth stones.
- **How the curse is undone:** The Zora part of the curse can't be undone, but the smooth stone part can be. They must simply give Link the smooth stones, as he is the only one who can destroy them.

The Musician of the Wind

There once was a hylian musician who sang so sweetly it melted the hearts of all. She even was able to make the champion fall for her. This did not please the goddess Hylia and she challenged the mortal girl to a singing contest. The mortal ended up winning as her song was sweet and sourful. In her rage the goddess turned the musician into a Rito and the judges of the contest into bird hybrids, the Rito. She than banished them to the mountains of Hyrule and forbade them from being with the champion. Like many other races created by the goddess, the Rito are also all female and must interbreed with Hylians.

- **Who:** Medli
- **Curse:** turned into Hybrid bird people
- **How the curse is undone:** The Rito can't be undone, but the seal of the wind will be broken once Medli, the reincarnation of the original musician, joins Link's harem.

Seal of Earth and Fire Spirit

Farm-girl

The champion did more than fight battles against primordial monsters and demons. He also helped with the work in the farmlands of Hyrule. There he took three sisters as lovers. This was the first set of lovers the champion took on and the goddess scolded him for being greedy. He cursed the three sisters and forbade them from ever being with the Champion again. If they did,

~~they would turn into cow hybrids. They of course stopped seeing the champion right away and went on to have empty marriages.~~

- ~~● **Who:** The Lon Lon sisters~~
- ~~● **Curse:** turn into cowgirls if they have sex with Link and they are forbidden from doing so~~
- ~~● **How the curse is undone:** To undo this curse they have to activate it. All three sisters must be turned into cowgirl hybrids and join Link's harem.~~

Desert Tribe

A group of hylia woman devoted themselves to the goddess hylia and wished to be her servants, just like the sheikah. They even decided to only be with one male, specifically the champion. Over time however, their admiration switched from the goddess to the champion and bearing the champions child become the highest honor to them. At first the goddess simply forbade them from being with the champion like she did with all others, she even cursed their ears to lose their points and grow small and round to show they had lost her favor. This did not stop the desert woman, so the goddess further cursed them to have only one male every 100 years and banished them to the deepest parts of the desert.

- **Who:** The entirety of the Gerudo race
- **Curse:** Round ears and only one male every 100 years
- **How the curse is undone:** Link has to have sex with them all and re-point their ears. They can only get their ears re-pointed by having sex with Link, thus showing that they are in the goddess's (zelda's) good graces again.

Seal of Time

The Seer

After the banishment of the goddess Malika to the demon realm, one of the goddess Hylia's most trusted servants confronted her. The seer of time, warned her goddess that if she did not act quickly to undo all the curses and wrong doing, there would be grave consequences. Hylia, knowing the seer secretly loved the champion, thought this was a trick by her servant and decided to punish her. She split the seer in two and banished both parts to a pocket dimension. A dimension that only a piece of the triforce could open.

- **Who:** Cia and Lana
- **Curse:** split into two and banished
- **How the curse is undone:** Link needs to re-fuse them into one person and have them join his harem.

Curse of Light

Hylia was a very proud and driven goddess. She wished to achieve much and was focused on solving any issue that would arise. This drive in combination with her pride would not let her see the consequences of her actions on those around her. After creating the perfect champion, she thought it was only correct that he only had eyes for her, the perfect goddess. Sure he would

have the sheikah, to produce offspring, but his love would be hers and hers alone. At first this seemed to be the case, but as the goddess became more distant and treated the champion more and more like a tool to be wielded, he became more connected with the other women in his life. At first the sheikah, then the ones closest to him and finally many of the women he helped. At first the goddess didn't even notice he had taken on so many lovers, when she did finally take notice she didn't think much of it. There was no other goddess in his life so she had nothing to fear. This all changed when the champion began having a relationship with the other remaining goddess, Malika. After betraying Malika and sending her to the demon realm, the goddess Hylia went on a cursing spree. First she was "nice" about it, but as she started to see the amount of women the champion had as companions, it enraged her. The curses became worse and worse, until the realm was in chaos and ruined.

It was after all this that Malika returned as the demon princess Demise. Demise intended to raise the entire kingdom of Hyrule but only found it already ruined by the now insane goddess Hylia. It was only because of this insanity and rage that Hylia was able to stop princess Demise. But princess Demise had one last trick, a curse of her own. Using all of the curses and negative energy Hylia had created, she cursed the goddess Hylia. A curse that would not allow her to be with the man she loved until all the other women she had attempted to stop were also with the champion.

After the defeat of princess Demise, Hylia realized what she had done. For the first time in her existence she didn't know how to fix all the wrongs around her. She had no one to turn to and had harmed everyone that she was supposed to care for. The goddess realized that her own mistakes and the horrors she'd wrought on her charges were unforgivable; she was not fit to be the goddess that defended them, any longer. So she cast off her divinity, seeking repentance and possibly a chance at fixing her mistakes through mortal reincarnation.

The Curse of Light is the final barrier keeping Zelda from having sex with Link, working as a kind of magical chastity belt. Only after all of the seals are broken will the final curse of light be lifted.

Notes:

Goddess Hylia didn't know how to delegate work

She ended up taking on too much work and didn't have time for the champion

She set the Hylian gender ratio to 75% women to 25% male since she saw women as superior

This caused a shortage of men and why so many women sought out the champion.

Hylia's pride wouldn't let her see she caused some of these issues so she brought the hammer down on everyone, starting with Malika.

Minor Curses

The Curse of Ganon

Ganon, the curse made real

As the seer had warned Hylia before, all the curses began to combine and form into an evil entity named Ganon. The ganon entity piggybacked off of Demise herself for her part in the final curse, subverting the demon queen into its fleshly form so that it could attempt to conquer Hyrule, and keep the curses from ever being lifted - thus ensuring its own eternal existence.

Curse of Desiccation

Gannon's ultimate plan is in motion. Using the combined power of all the curses, he will start to drain the land of Hyrule itself. The rivers will dry up and the land itself will turn to sand. This causes a drought across all of Hyrule. The only counter to this curse seems to be Link breaking a curse or Link's concentrated "Essence."
