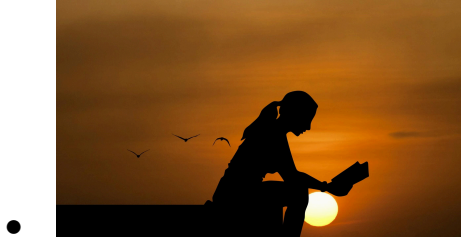


Stimson Middle School
