- ___ Senior sunrise event on the first day of school (unsanctioned)

- ___ Senior breakfast (unsanctioned)

- ___ Seniors will receive a paper package in the mail with college application process and related materials usually by the first week of October.
- ___ Yearbooks typically go on sale by DATE: April 4, 2026

Spring of Senior Year

- ___ Special senior items for yearbook due by DATE: XXXX

- ___ Order Senior Lawn sign by DATE (typically end of April)
- ___ Plan graduation outfit
- ___ *Review the overdue library materials email(s) that you child receives monthly from the library.*
 - ___ ***If you plan on attending Senior Ball, you must have no overdue materials or outstanding fines with the library prior to purchasing your ticket. If you do not plan on attending ball, you must have no overdue materials or outstanding fines with the library prior to collecting your cap and gown for graduation.***
- ___ Prepare for AP Course Finals in May - After school sessions are offered - stay tuned for those. Some sessions are on Saturday too!
- ___ A field day event takes place in May or June. Know the date! XXXX - canceled if students start senior assassin
- ___ Senior ball date: June 12, 2026
- ___ Traditionally, if you are a senior in good standing, the last day of school is a trip to Seabreeze. *WE MAY SELECT A DIFFERENT VENUE THIS YEAR. There is a cost. June 16, 2026.
