Resolution against trans and non binary violence

WHEREAS, solidarity is a cornerstone of policy to develop inclusive communities where individuals can develop and grow to be healthy and vibrant members of our cities; and

WHEREAS, overall violence has decreased in California, except for trans and non-binary adults and children who face staggering rates of verbal, physical, and sexual violence and victimization making for a fraught public life where they are targeted, threatened or abused; and

WHEREAS, states across the country and school districts in California are caving to hate groups and legislating against inclusion of trans and non-binary people, including children, in public and private life, and in schools and libraries and are banning related books, curriculum, and activities and criminalizing treatment thus further endangering this community; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Mateo County Democratic Party stands in solidarity with trans and non-binary people and we condemn in no uncertain terms all acts of violence, victimization, and efforts to prevent trans and binary people from fully and equal participation in California life and culture;

AND THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Mateo County Democratic Party requests that all 20 cities in San Mateo County and the County of San Mateo pass a resolution against trans and non-binary violence.
