



Learning Overview

Here is some information on some of the things we will be learning this term:

In Literacy (reading, writing, listening & talking), this term, pupils will be learning to:

- Communicate effectively with others to share ideas and information
- Discuss characterisation, plot and setting, recognising how these can be developed.
- Read with increased fluency, understanding and expression
- Read silently for extended periods (30-40 min.).
- Use the strategies and resources I know to help develop my understanding of a text.
- Review my writing to ensure it makes sense, is technically accurate and meets its purpose.
- Demonstrate that they value others' contributions through listening actively and responding appropriately.
- ★ Develop strategies and criteria for selecting
- texts that they enjoy.

 ★ Organise their writing in a clear structure with increasing independence.
- Experiment with sentence length and fluency.
- Develop their use of paragraphs
- Can show an understanding of what I listen to or watch by responding to literal, inferential, evaluative and other types of questions, and by asking different kinds of questions of my own.

In <u>Numeracy</u>, this term, pupils will be learning to:

- ★ Explain the link between a digit, its place and its
- Count, read, write, order and compare numbers beyond 5 digits, remembering the value of zero as a placeholder.
- ★ Can count, read, write, order and compare decimal fractions with tenths calculations, mental calculations and and hundredths. up to 3 decimal places)
- ★ Add and subtract whole numbers up to 1000 using a range of mental strategies and formal written algorithms.
- ★ Recall multiplication and related division facts with speed and accuracy.
- ★ Multiply and divide a whole number by a single digit using a range of mental strategies and use of formal written algorithms
- ★ Can add and subtract whole numbers up to 1000 using a range of mental strategies and formal written algorithms.
- ★ Can recall multiplication and related division facts with speed and accuracy up to 10x10.
- ★ Can multiply and divide a whole number by a single digit using a range of mental strategies and use of formal written algorithms.
- Can interpret and solve word problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
