All contests will be run under BJA rules as per the Tournament Handbook.

Golden Score: U20: unlimited. U35 3 minutes. O35 1 minute.

Strangles are not allowed where one entrant is aged 60 or more

Any queries or disputes on or off the mat will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision is final. The competition is run under BJA rules as per the Tournament Handbook. ALL players must have a white compliant judogi.

THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO: All BJA / BJC / AJA licence holders.

You must produce your Association's current licence on the day confirming your grade, or proof of grade via The Dojo (for BJA players).
